Activities for “Lonesome Charlie” story:

(Enrichment activities to follow reading the story; help from teacher or parent recommended.)

- 1) Make a list and write down each word that you do not know from the story. Then find and write the definition of each one, using a dictionary. Practice reading each word and learn its meaning.

- 2) Draw and color a plant that you like from the story, then write down a word that describes it.
Draw and color an animal that you like from the story, then write down a word that describes it.

- 3) Draw and color Charlie with his plant and animal friends in their “nature neighborhood” (scientists call their “nature neighborhood” a **habitat**).

- 4) Choose one plant or animal from the story and write a report about it. Ask your teacher or parent to help you find information for your report on-line or in books.
