

## **BIRDS SEEN HERE DURING APRIL 2026**

These 110 species of birds were reported in April on ebird ([www.ebird.org](http://www.ebird.org)) from Proctor Road and the trail that begins to your right. Clearly, April was lively, but May might even be livelier – the peak of spring migration. Along with many birds listed below, you can find different species a little farther up the Canyon.
