

## **BIRDS SEEN IN THE UPPER CANYON DURING APRIL 2026**

These 97 species of birds were reported in April on ebird ([www.ebird.org](http://www.ebird.org)) from the Mt. Wrightson Picnic Area and the trails in Madera Canyon beginning above this point. May's commonly the peak of migration – should be even busier than April.
